The Westport Police Alliance is proud to be able to offer the Sergeant Daniel Sullivan student scholarships this year. Scholarships will be awarded to beginning freshmen. Scholarships will be up to the amount of \$1000 each for college or university students.

### **HOW TO APPLY**

Detach and complete the accompanying application. Complete each & every question marking N/A if a question does not apply.

### **THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE STRESSES THAT EACH APPLICATION MUST:**

1. Be postmarked no later than April 15, 2019
2. Be returned to the "Westport Police Association P. O. Box 3051 Westport, MA 02790.
3. The outside envelope should be marked "Student Scholarship Application".
4. Application should be fully completed.
5. Application should be completed on the 2016 forms
- 6 Submit an official transcript of cumulative grade point average. Official transcripts must have the school's embossed seal on the transcript itself, or be placed in an envelope secured with the school's embossed seal.

The Westport Police Association Scholarship Committee will meet during the month of May to award the scholarships.

The recipient will be notified shortly after this meeting.

**Scholarship recipients are responsible for getting the attending institution's name and proof of acceptance.**

### **Eligibility:**

The applicant must be planning and eligible to continue his/her education at an accredited institution of higher education, within the year the scholarship is awarded. The applicant must maintain a **full-time student status**. All applicants must have a cumulative **grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale**.

**Criteria for Selection:**

The scholarship committee will consider scholastic achievement and excellence, extracurricular activities (school and community), honors, and awards as points of consideration in the selection process. Race, color, sex, creed, religious beliefs, national origin, or physical impairments will not be considered in determining recipients.

**Limitations:**

Any applicant shall be disqualified from receiving a scholarship if the applicant receives one or more of the following:

- 1. Acceptance or appointment to any of the service academies**
- 2. A scholarship /grant that is specifically designated for full-tuition and room & board.**

**Applications:**

Each prospective recipient shall sign his/her name in the space provided on the application form and by doing so, pledges to remain in school for the full semester following scholarship's award. The recipient further agrees to repay the Westport Police Association for the amount of the scholarship in the event that the student does not remain a full-time student for the semester immediately following the award.

In order to be as fair as possible, applicants must follow all directions. ***SEVERAL APPLICATIONS HAD TO BE REJECTED BECAUSE OF FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS.***
